

## Adair County Family Support Referral Map

**Definition:** Family support programs includes group-based parenting education or home visiting programs that are designed to strengthen protective factors, including parenting skills, increasing knowledge of child development, and increasing family functioning and problem solving skills.

Examples of Appropriate Referrals to Family Support Programs	
Scenario 1	Appropriate Referral
Primary caregiver resides in Adair County, is an <b>expectant first-time parent</b> who is receiving <b>FIP</b> benefits. She has completed the 11th grade and resides with her parents. She is interested in parenting information and support, as well as, getting connected to formal and informal supports in the community. <b>Proper nutrition</b> and eating during pregnancy are also concern.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Maternal Child Health</li> <li>• New Parent Program</li> <li>• FaDSS</li> </ul>
Scenario 2	Appropriate Referral
Primary caregiver resides in Adair County is <b>23 years old</b> . Expresses concerns over <b>social-emotional development</b> of her <b>2.5 year old</b> . She is also expecting another child and recently moved to Adair County. She is married and she and her 28 year old spouse have college degrees. She has chosen to stay home and they are at <b>200% of federal poverty</b> . Scenario 3	Appropriate Referral
Primary caregiver resides in Adair County, is <b>32 years old</b> and is 21 weeks <b>pregnant</b> with a second child. Mom is working part-time, struggles to keep employment, and has minimal support. She wants help locating needed items to prepare for new baby and not sure where to start. She receives <b>WIC, Medicaid, and FIP</b> and has questions regarding labor and medical coverage for when baby arrives.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Maternal Child Health</li> <li>• New Parent Program</li> <li>• FaDSS</li> </ul>
Scenario 4	Appropriate Referral
Primary caregiver resides in Adair County, is <b>28 years old</b> and has income equal or below <b>185% of federal poverty</b> with children ages 2 and 5 and receiving, FIP, WIC and/or food assistance. Mom is struggling to get nutritious food on the table for the children because she does not have the background to make the best food decisions.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• FaDSS</li> <li>• Parents as Teachers</li> </ul>
Scenario 5	Appropriate Referral
Primary caregiver is a <b>21 year old</b> male and has concerns that his two year old child is <b>not talking</b> and throws <b>temper tantrums</b> .	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Early Access</li> <li>• Parents as Teachers</li> </ul>

WIC = Women Infant and Children's (food program)

Hawk-i = Health and Well Kids in Iowa (health insurance program)

FPL - Federal Poverty Level

FIP = Family Investment Program (cash assistance to needy families)

Medicaid or Title 19 = health insurance
