Early Childhood Updates/Information

- The 4 R Kids ECI board has updated their indicators and information was disseminated
- CIAC is the coordinated intake for the homeless project and provided a brief presentation.
- The 4 R Kids ECI area collected information on the preschool experience rate, Dallas County rate is 81% which is a decrease from last year at 87.4%
- The FY20 Coalition meeting calendar was discussed, the calendar will mirror FY19.
- Samra Hiros presented tobacco control updates pertaining to Dallas County and gave the status of each initiative. Samra worked with two businesses who have successfully updated their workplace policies to tobacco-free and nicotine-free. Samra also talked about the reach of the recent Facebook Quitline Iowa ad during Valentine's Day week. She also provided the status on other initiatives she is working on. Dallas County Children's Advocacy Council Updates/Information

- The PCA Conference is May 6-7th in Ankeny and is 75% full.
- Dena provided an update on the Stewards of Children training that she has provided.
- Crisis Intervention & Advocacy is providing sexual abuse prevention education in the schools as well as adults in Dallas County.
- All of the GAX's and quarterly reports have been submitted to date.
- A committee is established to work on child abuse awareness activities that happen in April and will meet after the meeting.

Generation Wellness Update/Information

- A new substance abuse prevention contract was awarded to Crossroads Behavioral Health, but has contracted the prevention piece to Zion Recovery who will be serving Dallas County. The previous agency was EFR.
- Dena updated the group on the ACEs training that has been provided in the community.
- The Trauma Informed Care conference is June 3-4 in Des Moines.
- The Coalition reviewed the mental health resource list. Deb will update the list and post on the website.
- A Generation Wellness meeting will be 3-13-19 at Patrick's at noon.
