Tasks may include but not limited to suggesting public policy, problem solving, and providing guidance on community needs and issues. The coalition is in an advisory role to Generation Wellness (GW), Dallas County Children's Advocacy Council (DCCAC), and the 4 R Kids Early Childhood Iowa Area Board.	Generation Wellness Coalition (GWC) is to increase understanding among Dallas County community and governmental agencies about the importance of individual physical and mental health factors. To improve community response and resources regarding physical, mental health and substance abuse factors The group is committed to the Adverse Childhood Experiences (ACES). Perry Networkers is a provider meeting that that focuses on services for all ages in Perry and the close surrounding communities in order to better understand what services are available for families.	CPPC engages community members and agencies to reach out and support families before they face crises; intervene more rapidly when abuse and neglect occur; and join in a partnership to improve child protection policy, programs, and practice in ways that strengthen families and safeguard children. It is also an opportunity to refer community based Family Team Meetings for families. Recommendations are made by the CPPC team to the DCAT Board for spending purposes.
