Announcements

Zion Recovery Services

Dawn Walton is the prevention specialist that will serve Adair, Dallas and Madison County. Rhonda shared data from the Iowa Youth Survey. Adair county youth grades 6th, 8th, and 11th reported that 14% used any alcohol in the past 30 days, the state of Iowa is 10%

Fast Track to Child Care

A collaborative project between SWCC, ECI, Greater Regional, CCRR and Iowa works will offer an informational meeting how someone could become a child care provider. While this is targeted to Union County there may be room for other interested persons from surrounding counties. An information meeting will be held Monday August 26th from 6:00-7:30 at Pizza Ranch in Creston. The Fast Track class will be offered September 9th -13th in Creston.

FaDSS

The Family Development and Self Sufficiency (FaDSS) program has expanded the services to anyone that is caring for a child that is receiving Family Investment Program (FIP) benefits, grandparents are a target population.

Iowa Public Television

Nodaway Valley Schools has been selected as one of the possible southwest Iowa communities for this year, providing they can gather enough partners to be successful. They provide provide free resources and services to those who work with kids ages 2-8.

Treasurers Report

DHS is three months behind reimbursing for the services provided through SWCC. The new auditor is doing a good job complying with the rules set out by DHS and Prevent Child Abuse Iowa. The Council is grateful for the auditor to continue to support the council and its mission.

FY20 Contractor Update

SWCC Parents as Teachers provided an update on the families served, 5 families are currently being served.

Memorandum of Understanding

A 2021 memorandum of understanding between the Success 4 Kids Council and Community Partnerships for protecting Children is required to be signed and submitted to Prevent Child Abuse Iowa by September 16, 2019. This is a requirement in order to apply for funding in FY21. After much discussion it was consensus that the Success 4 Kids Council is to be the legal applicant for the request for proposal that is to be released in December or January. Stephanie and Kristie will facilitate the required signatures.

FY21 Planning

The FY19 request for proposal application was reviewed to garner possible guidance for the future RFP. The last RFP, three projects could be applied for out of the following four services, family support services, crisis care services, sexual abuse prevention and community development. It was consensus to continue to support family support services and to also apply for sexual abuse prevention as well as a possibility for community development. It must be clear as to what agency will take the lead for each program before submitting a proposal and the agency's involved would be required to assist with the RFP application. Letters of agreement would also be required for some of the programming.

American Lung Association

Samra Hiros provided an update on the action plan goals for Adair County. Samra has a presentation in Greenfield next week with Nodaway High School staff regarding electronic cigarettes. It is anticipated that 35 staff members will be in attendance. There will also be a Q&A session at the end of the presentation. Samra plans on putting together folders with additional information. At the coalition meeting, Samra provided county level data regarding tobacco use among 6th, 8th, and 11th graders taken from the 2018 Iowa Youth Survey (IYS). Here is a quick summary (please see attached IYS pages with information on other tobacco products). The 2018 IYS results indicated that 22% of 11th graders in Adair County reported current use of e-cigarettes (Iowa average is also 22% for the 11th grade). Another staggering increase is among 8th graders with 12% reporting current use of e-cigarettes. This is higher than the Iowa average for the 8th grade (8%). Ten percent of 11th graders reported current use of combustible tobacco products or cigarettes in Adair County. The American Lung Association is very concerned that we are at risk of losing another generation to tobacco-caused diseases as a result of e-cigarettes.

-10% of 11th graders in Adair County reported current use of **cigarettes**
-6% is Iowa average (for 11th grade)

-0% of 8th graders in Adair County reported current use of **cigarettes**
-2% is Iowa average (for 8th grade)
