- The Warren County Early Childhood resources map was reviewed and community partners were asked to provide Deb with any changes necessary.
- The HHS service delivery alignment project is having town hall meetings to get input from the community. Thursday July 13, 20023 at 10:00 at The Venue in Atlantic is the closest town hall meeting. There are not in person meetings in the metro.
- The 4 R Kids ECI area board invests heavily in evidence-based programming, 100% of the family support programs meet these criteria, overall close to 90% of all programs funded by the board meet the criteria.
