  - Warren County Health Services Community Health Navigator. I have plenty of Hawki materials to share, if your agency is interested in extra materials to pass out to clients, please reach out and I'd be happy to arrange a time to get those to you. If you have a client with children under 18 or pregnant individuals who need assistance in applying for Medicaid or Hawki I can complete a Presumptive Eligibility application with them. If approved this provides temporary 45- day coverage while their application is being reviewed for full ongoing benefits. They can self-refer or you can contact me with their information and I'll reach out. - There is a continued concern about increases in syphilis and especially congenital syphilis. 2023 preliminary data shows 13 cases of congenital syphilis which is more than 2021 at 11 cases, and more than 2022 at 8 cases.
